
In addition, we have a team of form tutors across Years 12 and 13 who support students both pastorally and academically.

The curriculum at Repton Dubai Sixth Form expands perspectives

The Sixth Form programme at Repton Dubai provides a comprehensive and well-rounded curriculum, carefully crafted to both inspire and challenge our students.

Within this curriculum, students have the flexibility to explore a diverse range of subjects, ensuring that there is a suitable pathway for every student who chooses to enrol with us.

Commencing in September 2024, students at Repton Dubai will have the option to pursue A Levels, BTEC qualifications, or a combination of both. Additionally, for those aspiring to excel academically, the opportunity to undertake the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) will be available. This qualification is highly regarded by universities and cultivates independent work and skills essential for higher education.

Alternatively, students may choose to pursue the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme. This involves selecting six subjects, with three studied at Higher Level (HL) and three at Standard Level (SL). Furthermore, all students undertake the 'IB Core,' which includes Theory of Knowledge (TOK), an Extended Essay (EE) and participation in Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS).

This holistic approach ensures a well-rounded and enriching educational experience for our Sixth Form students.



Entry Requirements

British Curriculum (A Level and BTEC)

- The general entry requirements for the A Level pathway are six GCSEs at Grade
 6 or above (or equivalent) including English Language and Mathematics.
- For the BTEC pathway the general entry requirements are five GCSEs at Grade
 5 (or equivalent) including English Language and Mathematics.
- ✓ Any students wishing to study a combination of A Level and BTEC, the entry requirements will be considered on an individual basis.

Please note: Some A Level and BTEC subjects have higher or additional requirements as outlined in the British Curriculum Options Booklet.

International Curriculum (IBDP)

- The general entry requirements for the IBDP pathway are six GCSEs at Grade 6 or above (or equivalent) for entry onto Standard Level (SL) subjects.
- ✓ For Higher Level (HL) subjects a Grade 7 or above at GCSE (or equivalent) is required.
- ✓ Students must meet the grade requirements for three SL and three HL subjects, which are outlined in the International Curriculum Options Booklet.

Please note: In exceptional circumstance, the application of the above criteria is at the Headteacher's discretion.

The following factors are used when assessing whether the above criteria have been met:

- ✓ Evidence of a sustained and committed approach to study throughout Key Stage 4.
- ✓ Predicted (I)GCSE results (or equivalent).
- ✓ Pastoral and academic staff recommendations.
- ✓ Attendance and punctuality record.
- ✓ Performance at interview.

British and International Curriculum Options Booklets





When selecting courses, students should consider the career that they wish to follow, the subjects which they enjoy and are most confident in and, of course, the subjects in which they are most successful.

The pathway that each student chooses will become the foundation upon which they will build their post-18 plans and future career ambitions.

Students can select from A Level, BTEC or IBDP subjects in our Options Booklets to develop their programme of study.

University Destinations





Location and Facilities


